







Objective : how to create a co-productive und inclusive atmosphere in meetings between service users and decision makers in the political setting

The aim is to generate techniques to create an inclusive and coproductive atmosphere and framework in the political setting.





Path



- First of all we want to find out what are the key issues for a coproductive behavior on the users and supporters point of view.
- We developed an questionnaire as a guidance and sent it to **self advocates and their supporters** which are working already in a coproductive way within their organization.
- We talked with them and asked questions.
- They sent us their answers from the questionnaire and told us their stories.
- First we localized **attitudes** which lead to a better understanding of co-production of all parties (users, policy makers, supporters).
- Then we identified the key elements of the **organisational framewor**k to establish a co-productive atmosphere.
- Finally we generated **techniques** for co-productive meetings.

Tools used (from wp1):

Self advocates and supporters are using the following tools:

- Chart of the participation pyramid
- Traffic-light cards: green/yellow/red
- Text in easy to read and with icons and symbols for all kind of information and minutes
- Graphic facilitation during the meeting





- Video statements
- Presentation techniques (flipcart)









Watch out!

To be avoid!

- Difficult language
- Lack of clarity about roles and tasks of all involved parties

Tips...

- clearify roles and tasks of self advocates and supporters
- take care of continuous support





- implement and use tools and guidelines for inclusive meetings
- undertake comprehensive briefing and debriefingsessions
- think out of the box: "Nothing is unpossible" or "everything is possible"
- undertake sessions of self reflection and annual reviews
