Some ideas for the "new design"of the guided tour

- 2 ways of proceeding:
  In each working place a user is trained to explain on that precise professional activity
  Or/and 1-2 users make the whole tour together with the professional.
- See what part the user can take and train that with him.
- See how many users should be prepared/trained for the guided tours in order to have enough available for the visit.
- Present yourself to the visitor: Who makes the introduction? Be clear on the words you use (terminology)
- Plan the tour together with the responsible professional
- Produce visual supports with illustrations or objects to show.
- make a test tour, let other users and professionals be the "guests" who can judge the quality of the tour ( to be considered later on in the evaluation phase
